

Leicester Rowing Club – Covid 19 Cleaning Products and Protocols

Wash your hands thoroughly before you start, and be careful not to touch your face, or other potentially contaminated surfaces during the sanitising process.

Please use the disposable gloves provided to operate the roller shutter door and dispose of them immediately.

BOATS AND BLADES – PLEASE CLEAN BEFORE AND AFTER USE

To clean the boat:

- 1. If necessary, rinse the boat over first with fresh water
- 2. Take a new disposable cloth, damp it with fresh water and add detergent. Use this to wipe all over the shell of the boat so it gets good and soapy
- 3. Use the same method to wipe over the riggers
- 4. Rinse off with fresh water
- 5. Turn the boat over and use the same method to sanitise the canvases and the cockpit
- 6. Use the alcohol spray to sanitise the shoes, foot stretcher(s), seat, gates and the ends of the slides
- 7. Ensure that all the touch points have been cleaned/sanitised
- 8. Put the boat away, or put it on the water immediately
- 9. Wash your hands thoroughly again

To clean the blades:

- 1. Take a new disposable cloth, damp it with fresh water and add detergent. Use this to wipe over the looms of the blades
- 2. Use the alcohol spray to sanitise the blade handles. Do not try to dry the handles off instead leave the alcohol to evaporate naturally

Private boats and blades also need to be sanitised, but may not require such thorough cleaning. Owners should use their discretion and clean their privately owned equipment so as to minimise the risk to others using the facility.

Equipment (slings, watering cans, buckets and any other items you touch), please use either the sanitising fluid on a clean, dry cloth, or the alcohol spray.

Please dispose of any cloths and gloves used immediately after use in the pedal bin provided.
